Stopping in a Bus Zone

Information for Motorists

Bus zones are located throughout the Noosa Shire. These zones are used by scheduled bus services to pick up and set down passengers in a safe location. Unless otherwise signed, bus zones are active 24 hours a day, every day of the year.

Stopping in a Bus Stop

A driver (except a driver of a bus) must not stop at a bus zone, or on the road, within 20m before a bus zone or 10m after the bus zone. Passenger transfer vehicles (e.g. Connexion) are not buses and are not allowed to stop or park in a bus zone.

What if I park my vehicle there?

Council Parking Officers conduct regular patrols across the region to ensure the safety of cyclists, motorists, and pedestrians. Stopping in a Bus Zone may result in a Parking Infringement Notice being issued in accordance with the State Law.

How can I report unlawful parking?

If you are concerned about a vehicle parked unlawfully, please contact Council and an officer will investigate the matter.
