## NOOSA PLAN 2020

Planning scheme for Noosa Shire

Noosa Plan 2020 came into effect 31 July 2020 and replaced all aspects of the previous planning scheme, including the mapping

The 'Noosa Plan 2020' module will automatically be selected. The layers that belong to this module can be turned on and off, using the check boxes next to each. If a layer has a '+' sign, this means that layer contains sub-layers, and it can be expanded to show these. The 'Noosa Plan 2020' module must be selected in order to view these particular layers. Please note, some layers can take longer than others to be turned on, due to the volume of data processed.



Once you have found a location of relevance to you, and you have the relevant hazard layers turned on, you can create a printable PDF of the map showing these features. Near the top of the page, select 'Export', then select 'Print' (red circle), select 'Raster', and then choose the 'Scale' calibration that best suits your needs. Once you have done that, select 'Print' (blue circle). The window or new browser tab (depending on the internet browser software you use) will appear, from there you can select to download the PDF.
