PLANNING SCHEME FOR THE SHIRE OF NOOSA

The local government for Noosa Shire first adopted the planning scheme on 19 January 2006. It commenced on 3 February 2006. Amended versions of The Noosa Plan took effect on 3 March 2008, 11 May 2009, 23 May 2011, 8 August 2011, 16 September 2013, 28 October 2016, 3 July 2017, 27 November 2017 and 8 June 2018.

STATE PLANNING POLICIES

The Minister for Local Government and Planning identified the following former State Planning Policies as being appropriately reflected in the planning scheme—

- 1. State Planning Policy 1/92: Development and the Conservation of Agricultural Land;
- 2. State Planning Policy 1/02: Development in the Vicinity of Certain Airports and Aviation Facilities;
- 3. State Planning Policy 2/02: Planning and Managing Development Involving Acid Sulfate Soils;
- 4. State Planning Policy 1/03: Mitigating the Adverse Impacts of Flood, Bushfire and Landslide (for Bushfire and Landslide only);
- 5. State Coastal Management Plan 2001; and
- 6. State Planning Policy 2/07: Protection of Extractive Resources.
